The COVID-19 pandemic is causing a worldwide crisis in 2020 leading, among other things, to a radical change in children's lives. How do children in different world regions feel, what do they know about the coronavirus and how can children's media help them deal with this extraordinary situation?



To answer these questions, an international study in **42 countries with more than 4,300 children** was conducted. 30 researchers from the international team will participate in this Info Night and share their findings and insights.
