

## PRIX JEUNESSE INTERNATIONAL Art Contest 2014: Feelings in Focus

This year: second art competition held as part of prestigious children's and youth festival,  
PRIX JEUNESSE INTERNATIONAL

**“Emotions – what they mean to me”:** this was the slogan of the second international art competition to be organized within the framework of the PRIX JEUNESSE INTERNATIONAL. The aim of the competition was to give young people a chance to express themselves, and to find out what they thought about this year's festival theme: **“Feelings in Focus – Emotions in Children's TV”**.

Munich, 14 July 2014 – Pictures were submitted by 6- to 18-year-olds from 12 countries (Argentina, Benin, Bulgaria, China, Estonia, India, Ireland, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Montenegro, New Zealand and Poland). An international jury selected 14 pictures which best illustrated the competition slogan. The emotion most often found in the drawings is love, but the children and adolescents also evoked themes such as joy, fear, anger and sorrow in their pictures. Envy and pride appeared less frequently.

Besides the three outstanding prizewinning pictures, other exceptional artworks were reproduced as posters and printed on roll-up banners. To acknowledge their tremendous artistic achievement, the three main winners received not just the posters and a certificate, but also an award.
